We are thinking about butterflies this week. Can you spot any when you go outside? Maybe you could find out what type it is with a grown up? Apparently they like over ripe fruit like mushy bananas, so if you put some out in a warm, sunny spot you might get to see more!

Make paper butterflies by drawing around your hands and cutting them out carefully. Decorate with patterns, stickers or sparkly bits. Don't forget that the wings are the same on both sides-they are symmetrical.


