


Week 15- EYFS Home Learning Activities

This week we are thinking about the story of Jasper's Beanstalk. If you don't have a copy of the book to share with someone, you could watch it being read on YouTube https://youtu.be/Da6lxY_8jmU by the author Nick Butterworth. Talk with your grown up about what plants need to grow and draw a picture of the things needed. Reception could write a sentence or label the parts of a plant too.

In the story, Jasper was hoping to see 'giants' at the top of his beanstalk. What would you like to see at the top of the beanstalk? Maybe you could draw or paint a picture and write a sentence to go with it.








Sun Safety - Talk with an adult about how to stay safe in the sun. Use the Slip, Slap, Slop slogan. Slip on a t-shirt, slap on a hat and slop on the sun cream.

Draw a poster to share your ideas.

Grow a bean in a bag - Place a few dried beans on wet kitchen roll and place in a zip sandwich bag. Attach the bag to the window and over the period of the week watch what happens. Reception children could draw, label and write about what happens during the week.





We will be looking at number 10 in Reception this week. Can you find all of the numbers that make 10? How could you show them – in number sentences, with dried beans, pictures or house hold objects? Maybe you could make a poster like we do in school all about the number 10.
