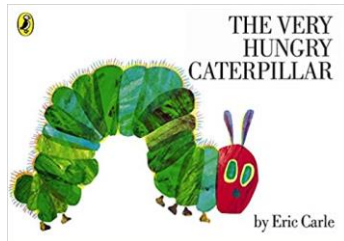


Week 13 EYFS Home Learning Activities

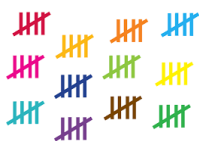
