

Week 16 EYFS Home Learning Activities

Hi Foundation friends. We hope that you are all having fun with the Home Learning Activities. We really enjoy looking at the work you have been doing so please keep uploading those photos and videos for us to see.



We are thinking more this week about beanstalks! Do you know the story of Jack and the Beanstalk? Perhaps you could read it with an adult or watch an animated version on YouTube.

Can you make a giant? Could you draw around an adult outside with chalk or even around their shadow? Do you have a roll of wallpaper to draw your giant on and cut it out? Decorate your giant.

Make a giant's foot. Use it to compare lengths. Find things that are longer, shorter and about the same length. Reception can make a list of the things that they find.



Jelly bean experiment. Separate the beans by colour and put them into cups. Then explore what happens to them in different liquids. You could use warm water, vinegar, salt water, milk and orange juice. Decide the time you are going to observe them for changes. It could be 15 minutes, 1 hour or 1 day. Discuss what changes you can see, the size, colour etc. After your observation time compare them to an original one, what has changed? Touch them to compare how they feel.

In reception this week we are looking at numbers 11 and 12. Watch the Number Blocks clips 11 and 12 on BBC iPlayer. Discover what 11 and 12 are made up of. Can you count objects to 11 and 12? Use your toys, sweets, pencils. Can you spot these numbers around your house? Take photographs to make a poster. After watching Number Block 12 can you create different arrays that make 12 using counters? 6 lots of 2, 3 X 4. Create an arrays poster.



The Giants Castle - what do you think it might look like? Can you draw, paint or make a 3-d model of a castle?
