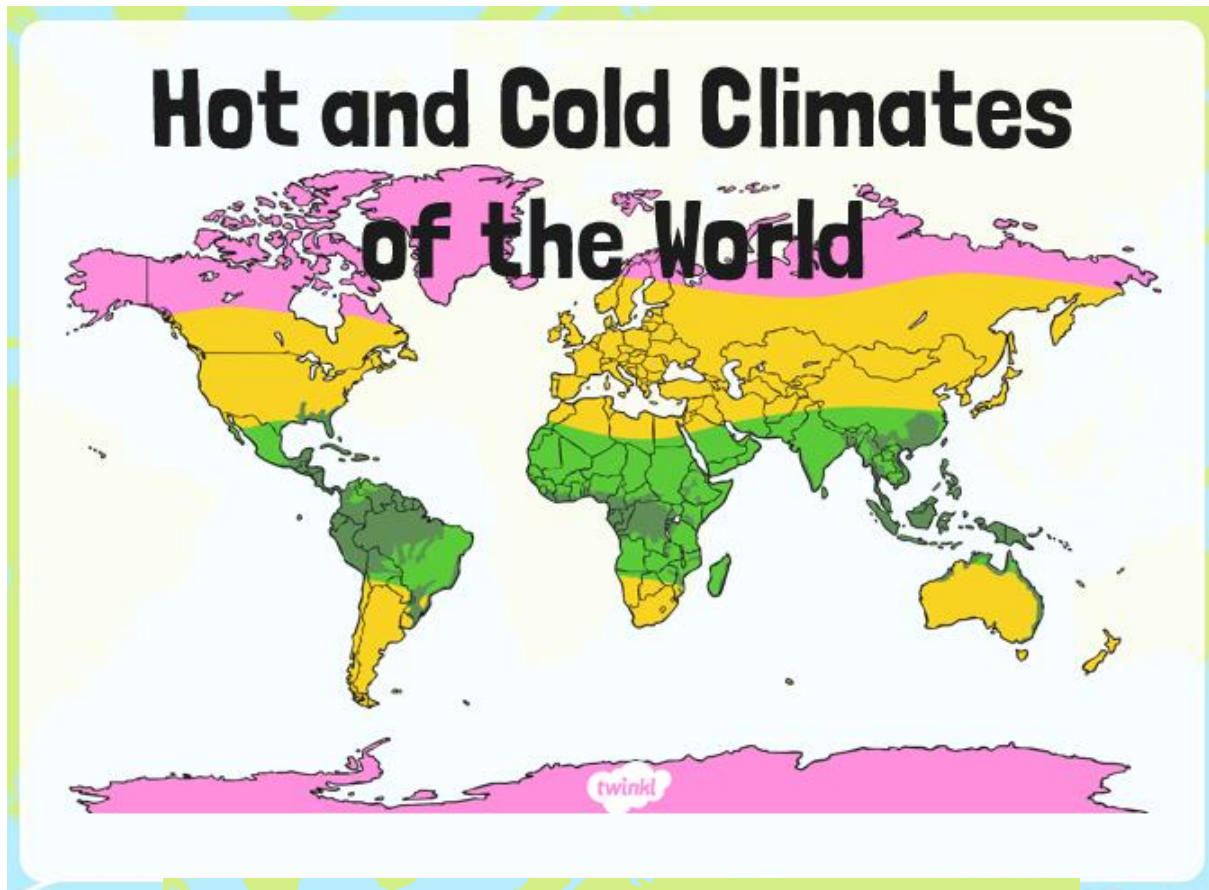


Week 16 - Geography

This week we are having a look at the different climates of the world and which animals live there. You may need some help from an adult, especially if using the internet to research.



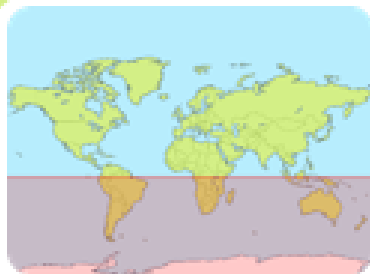
Aim

- I can understand the location of hot and cold countries around the world.

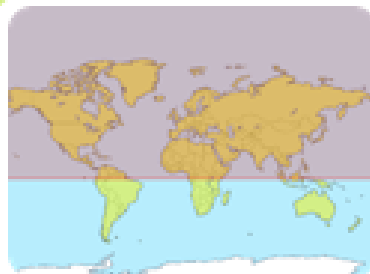

- I can understand how the location of hot and cold countries affects the different animals that live there.

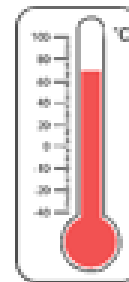

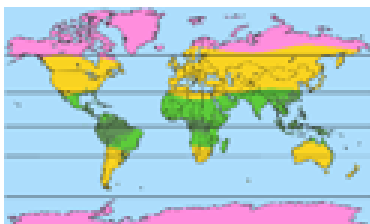

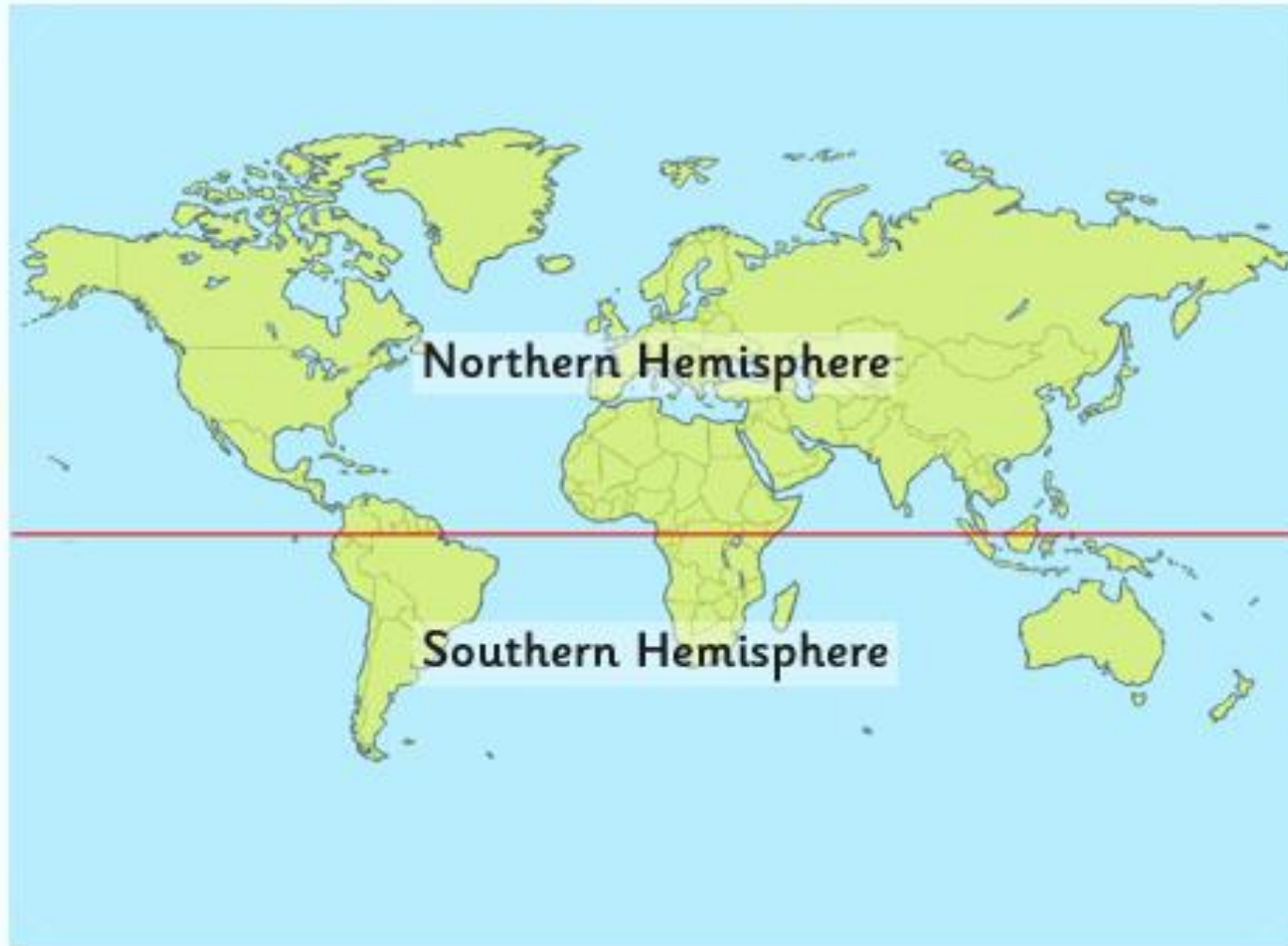

Weather

Climate is the average weather usually taken over 30 years for a particular place.

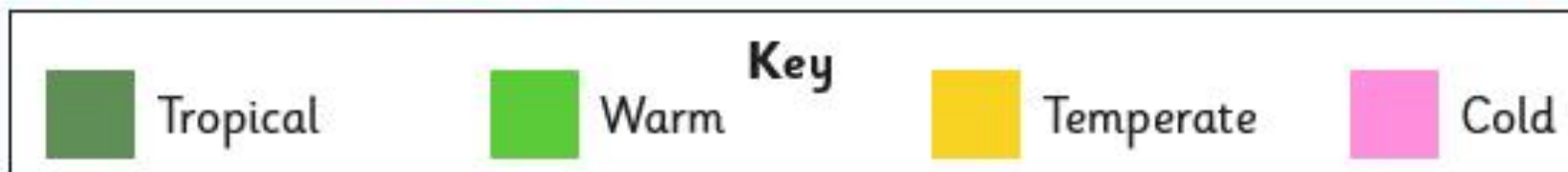
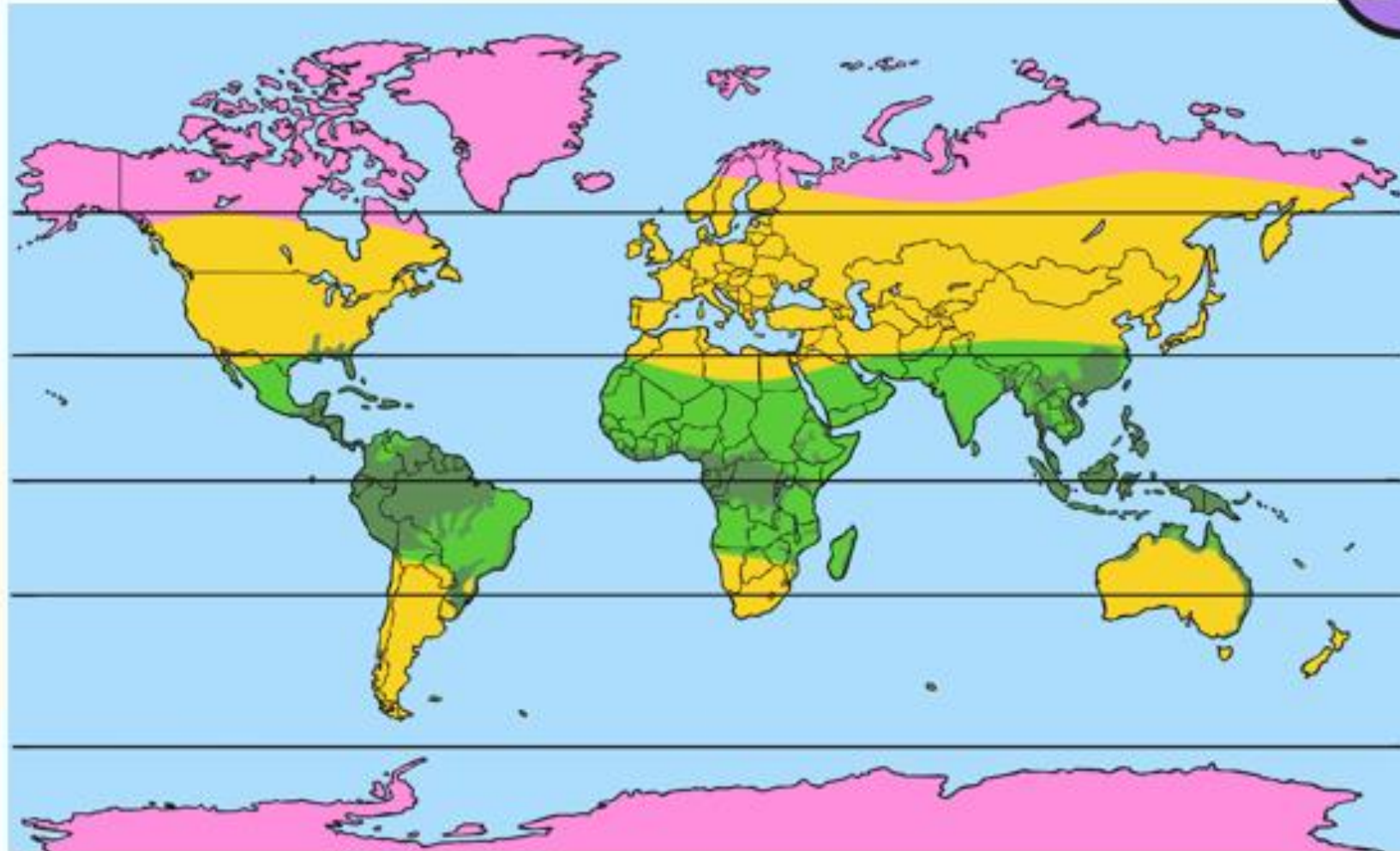
What is the weather like in our country?

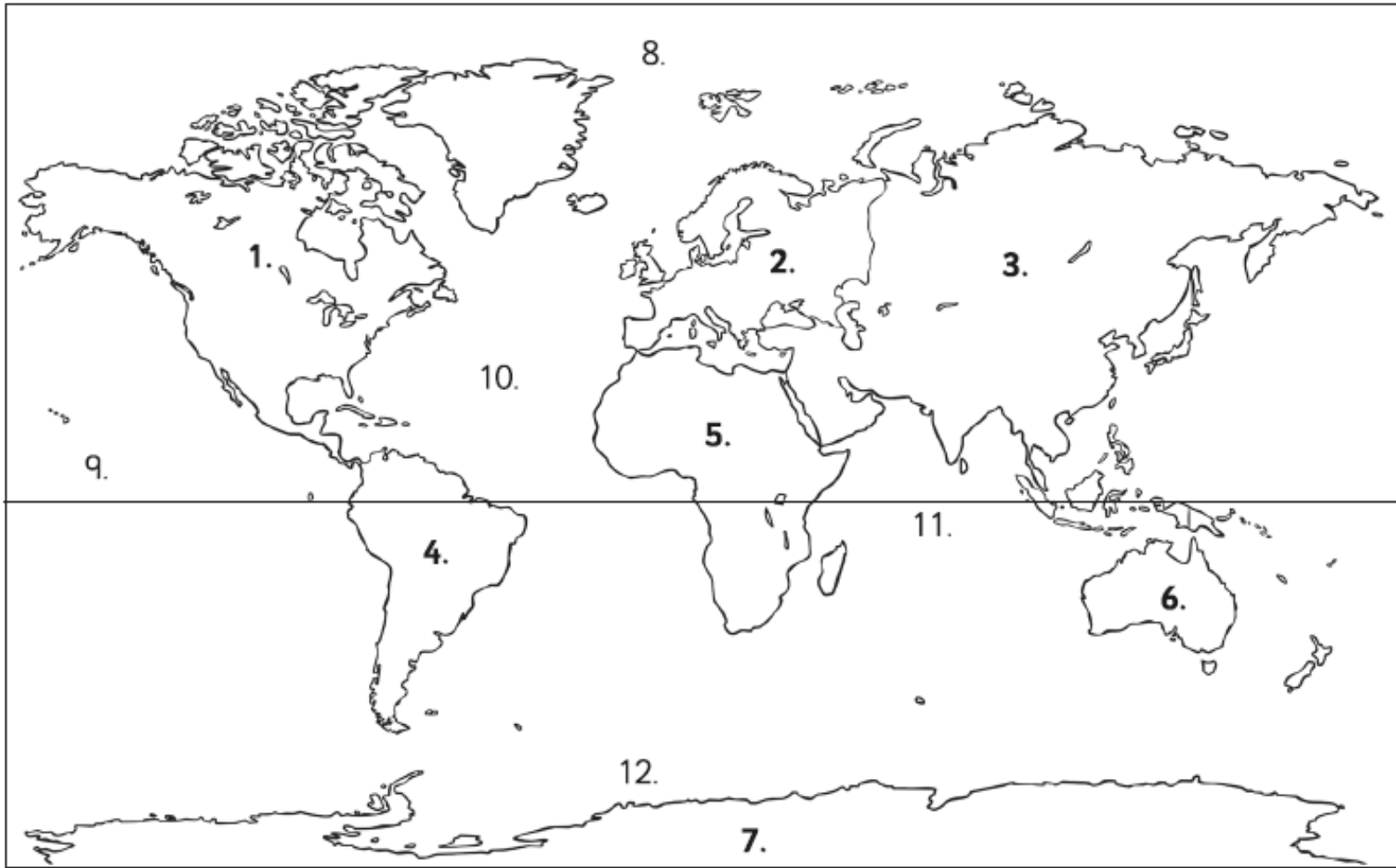
